#### West Nile Virus in Contra Costa County

The Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District (District) announces that one more group of mosquitoes, a chicken, and a dead bird have tested positive for West Nile virus. The group of mosquitoes was found in Antioch; the chicken was found in Holland Tract; and the dead bird was found in Brentwood. Birds are the reservoir for West Nile virus. The two species of mosquitoes in Contra Costa County capable of transmitting the virus prefer to feed on birds; however, people can become infected when a mosquito bites an infected bird and then a person. #### Child Safety Seat Inspections

### PUBLIC WORK

#### PG&E Projects within Brentwood

- Pipeline Safety Enhancement Plan Update:

As a part of PG&E's multi-year Pipeline Safety Enhancement Plan, PG&E is replacing an existing gas pipeline with a new 24-inch gas pipeline in Fairview Avenue. To date, PG&E has installed 3.5 miles of new pipeline, and completed welding inspections, hydro-testing and connection points.

On Monday, September 23, PG&E will fill the pipeline with gas and test the connection points. For safety reasons, Fairview Avenue southbound will be closed from Fairview Court to Balfour Road, and Grant Street will be closed in both directions at Fairview Avenue. Once this work is completed, PG&E will begin working on decommissioning the old gas pipeline and the last part of work will be the resurfacing and re-striping of Fairview Avenue, which is anticipated to be completed by late fall, weather permitting.

Detours are in place and traffic delays should generally be expected between the weekday hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Construction schedules during the fall school break (Sept. 30 – Oct. 11) may be adjusted to help expedite completion of this project. - St. Andrews Road Project:

This project involves the replacement of a gas pipeline on St. Andrews Drive between Mountain View Drive and Spyglass Drive. Work is continuing to progress and is anticipated to be completed by late fall.

- Minnesota Avenue Project:

PG&E will be adding an additional service line to improve service along Minnesota Avenue between Central Boulevard and Deer Creek just south of Bristow Middle School. Work is continuing to progress and is anticipated to be completed this fall.

City staff will continue coordinating with PG&E to ensure there are minimal impacts to the community and school traffic, and will be paying particular attention to the cumulative effects of these projects on traffic in the neighborhoods.


