## CCC FOOD BANK BROWN BAG PROGRAM

In Partnership with the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano Brown Bag Program, low income senior citizens receive free supplemental food twice per month. These groceries supplement the food seniors are able to buy on their own and stretches their dollars. To qualify for this program, you must reside in a low income household, live in Contra Costa County and be 55 years of age or older. 
## Sacramento Underground Tour

Lunch onboard the Delta King

A day in Sacramento



Hidden beneath the city for nearly 150 years, Old Sacramento's underground has long been the capital's best-kept secret. Today, you can join thousands of residents and visitors in uncovering the facts behind the legends that lie below our buildings and sidewalks. Your group will be divided into two tour groups to explore excavated foundations and enclosed

pathways while your tour guide recounts the tales of devastation, perseverance, and determination that led to California's only successful street-raising project. You will have time to tour the History Museum on your own before/after your tour.



A short distance away, you will board the Delta King, a unique Sacramento treasure for a delicious hosted lunch. The authentic riverboat plied the Sacramento River between San Francisco and Sacramento from 1927 to 1940. During World War II it served as a troop transport on San Francisco Bay. After the war the Delta King roamed the Delta, without a purpose or home. In 1984 the Delta King was brought to Sacramento where it underwent an extraordinary renovation at the cost

of \$9 million. Today it is a beautiful floating hotel with modern lodging amenities and 2 acclaimed restaurants offering casual and fine dining. Enjoy some free time to explore Old Sacramento before your return home.
