Highway 4/State Route 160 Connector Ramps Project

Partners from the Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA), Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC/Bay Toll Authority (BATA), and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) held a groundbreaking for the new Highway 4 to State Route 160 Interchange Project on Tuesday, May 20.

The Highway 4/State Route 160 Connector Ramps Project will construct two new connector ramps: one connecting westbound Highway 4 to northbound State Route 160, and one connecting southbound State Route 160 to eastbound Highway 4. The southbound State Route 160/Highway 4 separation structure will accommodate a future eBART extension in the median of Highway 4. This \$50 million project is being funded entirely by Bridge Toll Funds. Construction is expected to be completed in late 2015 or early 2016, weather depending.



2014/15 – 2015/16 Operating Budget

A public workshop regarding the draft 2014/15 – 2015/16 Operating Budget was conducted on May 27. The City's Operating Budget establishes the funding allocations for all of the services provided by the City, including police, parks and recreation, street maintenance and water, sewer, and garbage services. The total draft Operating Budget for fiscal year 2014/15 is \$184.5 million. The draft Operating Budget will be brought back to the City Council for consideration of approval on June 24.

Public Works Open House

Since 1960, the American Public Works Association has sponsored National Public Works Week (“NPWW”). This year, NPWW was May 18-24. In celebration of NPWW, the City hosted its 11th Annual Public Works Open House on Tuesday, May 20. City staff used this event to educate the public on the importance of the contribution of public works to their daily lives: planning, building, managing and operating the heart of our local communities that is a testament to the high quality of life in our City. There were approximately 400 visitors (300 students plus 100 teachers, chaperones and other visitors). City staff shared their expertise in water quality, water conservation, recycling, storm water, wastewater collections and backhoe execution, just to name a few. Rock Steady Juggling also contributed to this community educational event.



2014 Pavement Management Program – Slurry Seal

Sierra Nevada Construction, Inc. was awarded the above mentioned project at the April 22 City Council meeting. The work will begin next week and is expected to be complete by the end of July. The work has been scheduled during the school summer break to minimize traffic impacts in the neighborhoods.

This project will resurface 30 streets in several residential neighborhoods throughout the city, and Fairview Avenue from Balfour Road to Lone Tree Way, as well as two parking lots (Brentwood Senior Activities Center and Brentwood Family Aquatic Center). Portions of these streets will be temporarily closed while resurfacing is being done. Emergency vehicles,

however, will be able to access the streets during construction. Ingress and egress will be provided by necessary traffic controls. 


