
### CITY ADMINISTRATION

#### **Nominations for City Council**

The City of Brentwood will hold an election on November 4, 2014, for the purpose of electing two members to the City Council for four-year terms. Beginning on July 14, 2014, the City Clerk's office will begin issuing nomination packets. Those wishing to file nomination petitions must be registered voters residing within the Brentwood City Limits. Nomination petitions must be obtained from the City Clerk's office at City Hall, located at 150 City Park Way, Brentwood, CA, commencing on Monday July 14, 2014, and shall be filed with the City Clerk in person no later than 5:00 P.M. on August 8, 2014.

There is no fee associated with the nomination process. A candidate may file an optional Candidate Statement which will be published in the Election Materials. The Candidate's Statement is limited to 200 words, and a deposit of \$387.50 is required.
