C.C.T.A. 2014 Countywide Transportation Plan

The Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) is in the process of creating the 2014 Countywide Transportation Plan (CTP). CCTA has been the agency charged with providing and coordinating transportation improvements over the past 25 years through Measure C and Measure J, two transportation sales tax measures. In the past five years, sales taxes generated by these two Measures have funded the following major projects:

- Highway 4 Widening
- Fourth Bore of the Caldecott Tunnel
- eBart to Antioch
- New Carpool Lanes on I-680

All of the projects above and several smaller transportation related projects were results of the previous CTP. The 2014 CTP is the tool for shaping the future of the transportation in Contra Costa County including TriLink, eBart to Brentwood, and Vasco Road Improvements.
