◆ February

Certified Farmers' Market

◆ March – November

The Brentwood Certified Farmers' Market is held annually in Historic Downtown and has been recognized as one of America's Favorite Farmers' Markets. The market is open every Saturday from 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.



Downtown Saturdays

◆ May – November

Downtown Saturdays are held from May to November in Historic Downtown each with live music, outdoor dining, sidewalk vendors and family fun. Downtown Saturdays include Hot Brentwood Days (Car Show), OktoberFEST, Winter Walkabout & Tasting Tour, St. Patrick's Day Pub Crawl and Brentwood Blues & Brews concert.



Summer Concert Series in the Park

◆ June – August

The summer concert series is held every summer in City Park where families gather on Friday nights to listen to live bands.



Harvest Time Festival

◆ July

The Brentwood Harvest Time Festival is a two-day event held in Historic Downtown and City Park and celebrates the U-Pick experience, Brentwood Grown, and Buy Fresh, Buy Local. The event includes local food, entertainment, and fun for the entire family.



Art, Wine & Jazz Festival

◆ August

The Brentwood Art, Wine & Jazz Festival is one of Brentwood's largest civic celebrations. The annual festival is held every August and showcases the finest juried artists, premier local wineries, quality jazz performances, and the tastes of local restaurants.



Downtown Brentwood Craft Beer Festival

◆ September


